

Bourne Community Boating Family Cook-out Sailing Policy

- Students in the program may take a boat out if given permission by a supervisor.
- Sailors must adhere to the sailing area restrictions determined by the current conditions and the participant's skills.
- No intentional capsizing. Those that capsize, regardless of the circumstances will be sent or towed ashore.
- Swimming allowed only in marked area. Life jackets must be worn. Check in with the swimming supervisor before going into the water.
- Participant may bring their own boats, but must adhere to the sailing restrictions determined by the supervisor.
- Siblings may go out with a qualified student or supervisor with parental permission from a parent that will be present the entire time. A properly fitted life jacket and closed-toed shoes must be worn.
- Anyone present and wearing a properly fitted life jacket, may go out in a boat with a supervisor. Minors not in the program must have parental permission from a parent that will be present the entire time.
- A limited number of boats will be made available depending on conditions and the number of supervisors available. Participants should take turns using boats if not enough boats are available to accommodate those wanting to go out.
- Adults that want to take a boat out must pass the open sailing qualification test.

Supervisors will be stationed on the beach, float and in safety boats and will be carefully monitoring all on the water activities.
